



Acoustic Geophysical Wins Seismic Acquisition Contract in Poland

[March 25, 2011 – Budapest, Hungary] Acoustic Geophysical Services has won a seismic acquisition contract for a sizeable 3D project in Poland from San Leon Energy, an international group of companies focused on the exploration and production of oil and gas projects in Europe and North Africa.

The land seismic project will cover approximately 170 sq km, and is scheduled to begin in the second quarter of 2010.

Allan Sander, CEO for Acoustic Geophysical said that the expansion into Poland leverages the Hungary-based crew expertise in conducting operations in areas with environmental and surface culture restrictions. Sander expressed confidence that the company is well positioned to continue expansion that began in 2009 with projects in several other Eastern European markets .

John Buggenhagen, Director of Exploration for San Leon Energy commented that the Poland project will help move forward prospects for responsible shale gas development in Poland. The acquired data will help manage risk and improve the company's ability to develop its assets in the region.
